Directions: Write a story about what happens next.

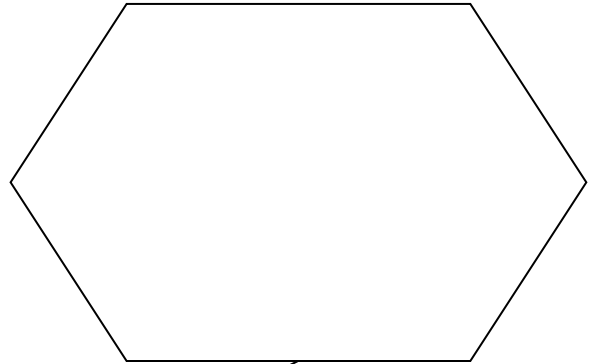
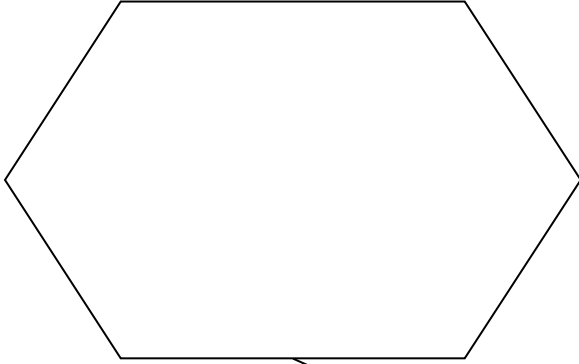
Remember: Make up a topic sentence that tells about the prompt.
